## Winter is Coming

The days and nights are getting colder. The wind is starting to blow. We have had one early storm, but more may be coming our way. It's time to check out the flashlights and lanterns and cover the outside faucets. Prepare for winter ahead of time by locating the tire chains and stocking up on deicer.

### Here is a list to help you prepare:

- Fresh batteries for flashlights
- Recharge any portable lanterns
- Firewood for fireplace
- Plastic to cover broken windows
- Keep prescription medication refilled
- Battery powered radio
- Extra cash
- Canned goods
- Manual can opener
- Keep cell phones charged
- Have one phone that does not require batteries
- Fill car with gas if a storm is forecast
- Extra pet food
- Camp stove or sterno burner to heat food (Don't use in the house)



Finally check on your neighbors! If you have gas hot water, gas cook top or a gas fireplace, invite neighbors over! Stay off the roads in case of a big snow.

If you are comfortable driving in snowy weather or have a 4 wheel drive car, offer to help our neighbors who may need help getting out and about.

## Speed Bumps Coming-Hopefully Will Ease Traffic Concerns

The UNA has been successful in our effort to get speed bumps installed near the driveways to Aqua Club. Starting in January a committee of interested neighbors met to discuss the traffic issues in Uplake. The conclusion was that too many cars are using Uplake as a convenient way to avoid 61<sup>st</sup> NE.

The group discussed the most troubling spots in the neighborhood and then contacted the City of Kenmore to ask for help. The two intersections that we asked for help on were the one near Aqua Club and the one at 60<sup>th</sup> NE and NE 182<sup>nd</sup>. The city agreed that the Aqua Club site was the most dangerous and asked King County to do a traffic study there. The conclusion was that speed bumps were warranted.

An informational meeting for the neighborhood was held on July 23 at Aqua Club to explain the process. The city next asked the UNA to get signatures from 62 residents in the area surrounding that intersection. With the help of these volunteers, **Rob Nelson, Bill Weber, MaryBeth Anthony, Tina Montgomery, Colleen Anderson, John Osborn, Eileen Ballard, Courtney Gebhardt, and Linda Ottmar**, we were able to get enough signatures to OK the speed bumps.

In the meantime we have had another accident at the intersection of 60<sup>th</sup> NE and NE 182<sup>nd</sup>. We will continue to let Kenmore know about our safety concerns there. If this area concerns you, you can go onto the City of Kenmore website and fill out a Citizen Request Form found under the "contact Info" tab.

## RATS, RATS, RATS


Neighbors have reported many sightings for these pests. They have been seen eating vegetables and fruits in gardens, climbing trees, and running across the streets even in broad daylight. In fact, Seattle has been listed as one of the top 10 rattiest cities in the nation! Not an honor we want to boast about.

There are several things we can do to keep the pests under control. Be sure to feed your pets inside. Rats love dog and cat food. Unfortunately, they also love birdseed. Compost piles unless tightly covered attract rats. Be sure to clean up after your dog because that is another favorite!!

Neighbors have had success with snap traps and baits. Just make sure that if you use poison that it is in an enclosed trap so that pets and children do not touch it. As cold weather comes they try to find ways into our homes. Check around your roof and foundation and caulk or place screening on any even very small openings. Stuffing steel wool into opening also helps.
