#### **Email Addresses**

#### **Highway 522 Construction**

Perhaps we are getting closer having this part of the project finished and that might reduce the number of cars using our neighborhood to bypass the work on 61<sup>st</sup>. There is a now a safer way to get to the Burke Gilman Trail, however you need to cross over to the "Jack in the Box" corner first.

The next project on Hwy 522 will be in front of Uplake and won't start for a year or two. When that happens the left turn lane into Uplake will be closed and we will do a u-turn at the 61<sup>st</sup> intersection to come back to our main entrance. This should eliminate the cars that are using Uplake to bypass the light at 61<sup>st</sup> and Bothell Way.

#### Speeding on NE 182<sup>nd</sup> and 60<sup>th</sup> NE

Residents are noticing increased traffic on the "Goat Trail" and NE 182<sup>nd</sup>. Many cars are coming through the "Goat Trail" and then speeding down NE 182<sup>nd</sup>. This especially happens during the morning and evening commute. We are asking Kenmore to put the radar trailer on NE 182<sup>nd</sup> to remind drivers that the speed limit is 25 mph. If you are concerned, call the City of Kenmore (425-398-8900) with your complaint as this will draw attention our problems with speeding drivers.



#### **Parking at Our Entrances**

We have noticed that there is increased parking at both entrances to Uplake. It appears that it is usually not Uplake residents who parking there to take the bus. Despite 4-hour parking signs others consider our streets a very convenient place to park and take the bus. When you see cars parked there for more than 4 hours let the board members know so we can inform the police.
