Uplake Traffic Issues

All of us were notified by postcard last fall about a meeting in early December to tell the City of Kenmore about traffic woes in our neighborhood. Two of your board members went to the meeting along without 10-15 other residents of the area bounded by NE 190th, 61st NE, Bothell Way and Lake Forest Park. Most attendees cited the same issues as concerns.

The intersection at NE 190th and 61st NE was the top issue due to sight line problems. Other problem areas mentioned were the intersection of 60th NE and NE 182nd, the lack of fog lines in all areas of Uplake, traffic using Uplake as a bypass to 61st NE, stop sign at the bottom of NE 187th, and the inability to turn left at the new stoplight(61st NE and NE 181st) during times of high traffic. Some of these issues may be resolved or lessened when construction on the Bothell Way intersection is completed.

The next step is to have another meeting to prioritize our needs. The City of Kenmore has authorized the spending of about \$17,000 to address Uplake's concerns. We will again be notified of the next meeting.

In Memoriam

Unfortunately, Uplake lost some long time residents recently. **Don Williams** passed away in November. He and his wife **Pat** moved into Uplake many years ago and Don lent his expertise to the UNA.

Samuel Rieger passed away also in November. He and his wife **Olga** had lived in Uplake for a number of years.

Rob Stimmel, son of **Bob and the late Joan Stimmel**, died in a Florida plane crash in November. Rob was raised in Uplake along with his brothers and sister.

Have you spotted the little library on 60th NE? It is located just off 60th close to the entrance to the lower Aqua Club parking lot.


Built and maintained by the **Clasen Family** it contains books for preschoolers. Bring some and borrow some!



Trouble with White Bark Birch Trees

Have you noticed that birch trees seem to be dying from the top down? During our dry summers evidently these trees have not been getting enough water and the tops start to die out. In fact it is said that birch trees really like to grow in areas where their feet are wet like near swamps or rivers.

Several birch trees in Uplake have had this problem. What happens next is the dead top main trunk and limbs are prone to being blown off in winds. These are large and heavy and can cause damage. If you own one of these trees you may want to check with an arborist to determine if it is dangerous.



Garbage Cans out of Sight

This is a reminder to please take your cans in as soon as possible after pickup. Thank you to all residents who are diligent about this and who also hide their cans behind shrubbery, in the garage, or behind their homes.

RATS

Sorry about the topic-we have had neighbors report an unusual increase in RATS. We understand that when the weather turns cold we notice rats more as they try to find warmer places to live!! We have had residents see rats running across decks on top of railings and fences and even in cars! In addition to setting traps, some neighbors are calling exterminators. This problem is not limited to our neighborhood however, as other areas have noticed increases too.

One neighbor has had success with trapping them with a Victor Electronic Trap, available at Home Depot.
